In PSE, we will focus on our mental wellbeing as well as *Being me in my world*.

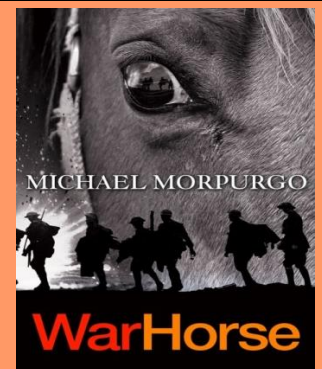
In PE we are enhancing our skills in games.

We will use *War Horse* as a vehicle to investigate word classes; discuss effective synonyms and antonyms; identify subjunctive verbs; examine the author's use of punctuation; and apply what we have learnt to our own formal and informal writing.



As Mathematicians, we will be consolidating our understanding of place value; revising addition, subtraction, multiplication and division; extending our knowledge of decimals, fractions and percentages; and practising our reasoning and problem solving skills.
