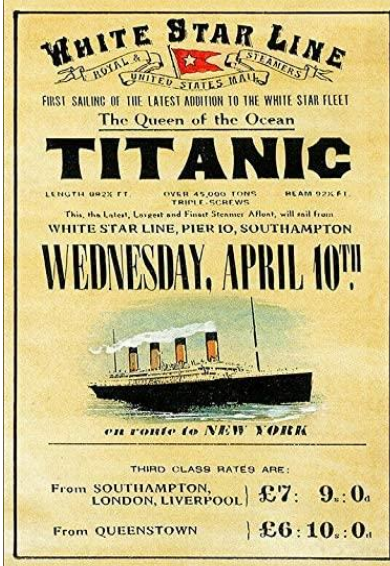




Year 2 Spring 1

Maths

We will be practising doubling and the 2, 5, 10 and 3 times tables. We will be recapping odd and even numbers and diving by 2, 5 and 10. In statistics we will be making tally charts and drawing and interpreting pictograms.

We will be working in a fun and hands on way to learn about famous **Scientists and Inventors**. We will learn about Elizabeth Garret Anderson, the first woman doctor, Louis Pasteur and his work on germs, Rachel Carson and her research on ocean habitats and the development of wind turbines.

In IT, we will be Communicators.

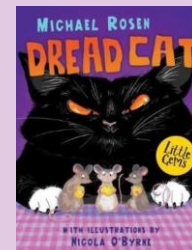
We will be using a word processing program to write letters, information texts and newspaper reports.
